Lower Division (preparation for the major 20 units) *Required:* 4 lower division, two courses from each group:

Group A (10 Units)

Art His 20 – Ancient Art (Formerly 50)
Art His 21 – Medieval Art (Formerly 51)
Art His 22 – Renaissance & Baroque (Formerly 57)
Art His 23 – Modern Art (Formerly 54)
Art His 24 – Architecture in Modern World (Formerly 58)

Group B (10 Units)

Art His 27 – Art & Architecture Ancient Americas (Formerly 55B)
Art His 28 – Arts of Africa (Formerly 55A)
Art His 29 – Chinese Art (Formerly 56B)
Art His 31 – Arts of India and S.E. Asia (Formerly 56A)

Note: To declare an art history major, all 4 lower division courses must have been taken.

Upper Division *Required:* 11 upper division art history courses as follows:

3 courses (12 Units) with one taken from each of the following historical periods:

Ancient/Medieval (Before 1400) (4 Units): M110A through M110C, M111, M112A through M112D, M113A, M113B, M114A through C114D, C115A through C115F, C116A, C116B, C117A, C117B, M118A, 119A, 119B, C139A, C148A, C148B, 154A

Early Modern (1400 – 1700) (4 Units): 121A through 121D, 124A, C125A, C125B, C126A, C139B, C139C, C141A, C148C, C148E, C152B, 154B

Mod./Contemp. (1700 – Present) (4 Units): M118B, 127A through M127C, C128A through C128C, C129A through C129C, C130A, C131A through C131C, C132A, C133A through 133E, C134A, CM135A through CM135C, C142A, C142B, C145B, C148D, 154D, C160A, C170A

3 courses (12 units) taken from at least three of the following geographic regions:

Africa: C145A, C145B, C146A

Asia: C148A through C148E, C149A, 150A, C150B, C151A, 152A through C152D, C153A, 154A through C154C, 154D, C155A, 156A, C157A, C158A

Europe and the US: C115B through C115F, 121A through 121D, C124A, C125A, C125B, C126A, 127A, 127B, M127C, C129A through C129C, C131A through C131C, C133A through C133E, C134A, CM135A through C135C, CM136A, 137A, C170A

Latin American and the Caribbean: C139A through C139C, C140A, C141A, C142A, C142B, C143A, 144A

Mediterranean, Middle East and Near East: M110A through M110C, M11A, M112 through M112D, M113A, M113B, M114A through M114c, CM115A, 119A, 119B

Electives *Required: Minimum 20 units*

Additional art history electives selected from courses 100 through 185 are required; course 196, 197A, and 197B may also be included. With prior approval of the Undergraduate Advisor, one of these classes may be taken in another department.

Required (44 Units): 11 upper division art history courses as follows:

3 courses (12 Units) from **historical periods**

3 courses (12 units) from three **different regions**
